**THIS MEETING WILL BE HELD PRIOR TO OUR REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING ON THIS DAY**

**ARTICLE 5.5**

**PRESENTLY READS:** DUTIES OF THE TREASURER shall include but not be limited to:

- a) Be custodian of all Association funds.
- b) Signing authority for checks shall be: The treasurer for any approved checks up to and including \$600.00 per check. Any approved checks in excess of \$600.00 shall be the Treasurer plus any one of the following: President, Vice President(s) or Secretary.

**PROPOSED CHANGE:** DUTIES OF THE TREASURER shall include but not be limited to:

- a) Be custodian of all association funds.
- b) Signing authority for checks shall be: The treasurer for any approved checks up to and including \$600.00 per check. Any approved checks in excess of \$600.00 shall be the Treasurer plus any one of the following: President, Vice President(s) or Secretary. **In the absence of the treasurer, these duties would fall on the President, Vice President(s) and/or the Secretary until such time as the treasurer returns or another member is secured for the position.**

**ARTICLE 6.1**

**PRESENTLY READS:** The annual meeting shall be held the first Monday of February each year in the Lake Pointe Village Recreation Center. Each member shall be notified of the meeting in writing, by mail or hand delivered, plus a notice shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the Village, at least fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting. An officer of the Association shall provide an affidavit affirming that the notices were mailed or hand delivered.

**PROPOSED CHANGE:** The annual meeting shall be held the first Monday of February each year in the Lake Pointe Village Recreation Center. Each member shall be notified of the meeting in writing, by **USPS** mail, **e-mail** or hand delivered, plus a notice shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the Village, at least fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting. An officer of the Association shall provide an affidavit affirming that the notices were mailed or hand delivered.
